
We decided that we would no longer simply build and sell furniture but would propose "integrated design solutions".

To do this, we have implemented a flexible organization, with a service center – **the Saporiti Hub** – based in Italy, in the traditional Saporiti Italia offices, and a series of international sales and project management bases – **the Saporiti Network**.



The Saporiti Italia Collections

Even if today the core business of Saporiti Italia is the creation of "turnkey" projects, we continue to design and develop new products and continue to produce and sell our historic furniture collections.

Objects designed by masters of international architecture and design, such as Alberto Rosselli, Salvati & Tresoldi, Giovanni Offredi, Pierluigi Cerri, Martì Guixè, Doriana & Massimiliano Fuksas, Toshiyuki Kita, Daniel Libeskind, John Portman, Shin Takamatsu, James Wines / SITE, Carlos Zapata and more.

Some of Saporiti Italia's products have been exhibited in the most famous design and art museums in the world, such as the Museum of Modern Art in New York, the Museum of Contemporary Art in Los Angeles, the Museum of Modern Art in San Francisco, the Victoria & Albert Museum in London, the Museum of Contemporary Art in Antwerp, the Triennale in Milan and others.











Since the 70s and 80s, Saporiti Italia has approached the world of art. In those years, however, the main aim was to give value to furnishing objects, to architecture, to the interiors of an environment, combining them with art or elaborating them with the language and uniqueness of art.

From the early 2000s, however, we began to **think about communication and at the same time design systems at the service of art,** in particular art places, which by their nature need functional furnishing objects with their unique characteristics.

Thus the "Saporiti Italia - Inside Art" project was born in 2006, which aims to create objects, installations, and events in museums and places of culture.

From a technical point of view, Inside Art allows us to experiment and create very interesting and original objects.

From a communication point of view, it is even more important:

- on the one hand, it allows us to associate our research and our objects with the world and the value of works of art
- on the other hand, it has a high cultural and social value, because these initiatives contribute to supporting and financing places of art and culture.

Inside Art is the ideal continuation of the research and communication projects carried out by Saporiti Italia in the first decades of its life.

An example is the important «Moderno & Moderno» exhibition created in February 1983 by Saporiti Italia in collaboration with the Galleria II Milione in Milan.


This unique exhibition of its kind, especially in that period, was placed alongside thirty of the most interesting pieces designed for Saporiti Italia between 1960 and 1983 by designers such as Alberto Rosselli, Vittorio Introini, Giovanni Offredi, Salvati & Tresoldi, with as many works of art of some of the greatest masters of Italian art of the 20th century, including Burri, Capogrossi, Dorazio, Fontana, Manzoni, Melotti, Merz, Paladino, Pistoletto, Rotella, Schifano, Zorio.

My Miamina

Miamina Armchair

Design Studio Salvati & Tresoldi, 1983



In 1983 Salvati & Tresoldi proposed to Saporiti Italia to produce a "homage" to the Tripolina, the folding seat in wood and fabric used by the British army in the African campaigns of the 19th and 20th centuries.

Saporiti Italia creates an innovative structure in steel tubes, connected by an advanced spheroidal cast iron joint.


The seat is composed of a sandwich of structural fabrics and a colored cloth for Saporiti Italia by Ottavio and Rosita Missoni, or made with relief-printed leather by Guido Pasquali or with woven leather by Gegia Bronzini.

Miamina was presented in 1983, first in the Saporiti Italia showroom in Miami, from which it takes its name, and then in an extraordinary exhibition at the Rotonda della Besana in Milan.













In 1987, Professor Ardito Desio, geologist, explorer, mountaineer, and organizer of the first ascent of K2 in 1954, and the mountaineer Agostino Da Polenza, director of the Everest K2 CNR scientific committee, asked Saporiti to help create the highest laboratory research in the world:

the EV-K2-CNR Pyramid, created at the base camp of Mount Everest at 5,050 meters above sea level.

Saporiti Italia sponsors the construction of the pyramid laboratory, creating the interior with special ultra-light materials and creating a special edition of the Miamina, with a lightened structure and canvas designed by the famous graphic designer Bob Noorda.









In October 2023, Saporiti Italia organized the exhibition ART COLORS DESIGN / Salvati & Tresoldi x Saporiti Italia at the ADI Design Museum in Milan, which retraced ten years of intense collaboration between the Besnate company and Studio Salvati & Tresoldi.

The Miamina armchair is the absolute protagonist of the exhibition, both in the historical editions, created by famous artists, graphic designers, fashion designers and in a special edition «Miamina – Twenty Cities» created by the artist FoscaMilano and dedicated to twenty cities in which Saporiti Italy has its own offices or has carried out important projects.


Dubai Innovation and Design Institute Poli.DESIGN Milan Accademia di Brera and MA*GA
